AGENDA NOTES

16.1 Welcome to the members by Chairman

At the outset, Principal welcomed Hon'ble Chairman and all the members present in the 16th BoG meeting and thanked them for attending the meeting. The Chairman, Board of Governors addressed the members present in the meeting and gave his kind consent to start the meetings as per the agenda...

16.2. Confirmation of minutes of the 15th meeting of the Board of Governors held on 20th October 2023

The proceedings of the 15th meeting of the Board of Governors (attached as Annexure-I of the agenda notes) held on 20.10.2023 was circulated among all members, since no comment was received from any member; the proceeding of 15th BOG is confirmed.

16.3 Action Taken Report on the Minutes of the Meetings.

The Action Taken Report (attached as Annexure-II of the agenda notes) on the decisions/recommendations of 15th meeting of the Board of Governors held on 20.10.2023 is reviewed and recorded.

16.4 Approval of the 2nd Building & Works Committee Metting held on 06.02.2024

The Principal apprised the Board that the 2nd Building & Works Committee meeting of the Institute was conducted on Dt.06.02.2024. The Committee has recommended one proposal for the painting of inside walls of D-Type quarter amounting to Rs. 3,71,000.00 (Rupees Three Lakh Seventy One Thousand) only and payment of Rs. 70,00,000/- (Rupees Seventy Lakh) only to IDCO for the ongoing projects of Smart Class Rooms, Cafeteria and Environmental Sustainability Plan of the College (Attached as Annexure-III in the Agenda Notes). The Board went through the proposal and approved the same and also approved the payment to IDCO.

16.5 Approval of the 2nd Finance Committee Meeting held on 06.02.2024

The principal apprised the Board that the 2nd Finance Committee meeting of the College was conducted on Dt.06.02.2024. The proceedings of the same is attached as Annexure-IV in the Agenda Notes. The Board approved the same.

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16.6 Approval for Reimbursement of the Registration Fee for at least one Professional Society to the Regular Faculty Members

The Principal requested the Board to accord approval for reimbursement of Annual/Life Time Registration fee to be a member of the Professional Societies like IEEE, ISTE, IE, CSI etc. from the Sustainability Fund. The 13th and 14th BoG meeting had approved to reimburse the registration fee, TA, DA for attending Conference, Workshop, FDP etc. from the TEQIP sustainability fund limiting to Rs.20,000/- per faculty in one academic year. The Board approved the reimbursement of the registration fee to be member of the professional society within the above Rs. 20,000/- approved in the earlier Board.

16.7 Approval of the Holiday List for the Academic Year 2023-24

The Principal informed the Board that BPUT, Odisha has published Holiday List for the year 2024 as annexed in Annexure-V of the agenda notes and requested the Board to approve the same to be implemented for our institute. The approved the same.

16.8 Approval for the renewal of Plagiarism Software (Turnitin iThenticate) for 50 users

The Principal apprised the Board that all the regular faculty members have requested to procure the Plagiarism Software (Turnitin iThenticate). The cost of subscription for one year for 50 users will be approximately Rupees Five Lakh only. Many of our faculty members are pursuing Ph.D., some faculty members are guiding Ph.D. students and many of them are involved in research work. For any of the accreditation like NBA, NAAC or ranking like NIRF, research publication is a basic necessity. The Electrical Engineering Department got NBA accreditation as the publications by the faculty members is maximum. For publication of any research article, plagiarism check is a must. All the institutions and universities of higher learning like NIT, IIT have subscribed the plagiarism check software. Hence, the Principal requested the Board to approve the procurement of the above software. The Board approved the same.

16.9 Approval for procurement of a Firewall for the College

The Principal apprised the Board that in the 15th BoG meeting approval has been given for the procurement of a Firewall for the College. The approximate cost for the same for 1000 concurrent users will be approximately Rupees
